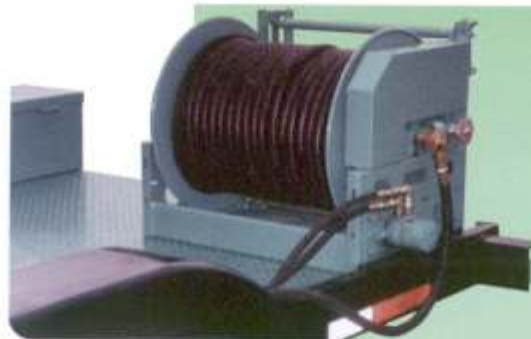
The Avalanche system makes sense. Our modular designs give the contractor maximum flexibility in configuring the trailer rig. If your company is equipped to handle 55-gallon drums, we'll build the system to carry and pump from drums. **Use bulk totes?** We'll set you up with a system that allows you to take advantage of the cost savings of buying your spray grade materials in bulk. Take some time and look at the features and options you get with the Avalanche Spray Rig from Garlock.



Our basic package starts with the Standard Commander 2120 Sprayer set up for 55 gallon drums. The Commander Sprayer is our toughest, strongest sprayer built to handle the heavy mastics and everything below it. If it's spray grade material, the Commander can get it done. Rated at 4500 psi and 5 gpm, the Commander Sprayer features simple, automatic operation. The full panel instrumentation shows you exactly what pressure you are spraying at. It's so simple. You don't even need to climb up on the trailer to run it, other than to change the barrels. Everything is within arms' reach, right from the ground. ▶



We feature a 300' capacity hydraulic hose reel that automatically feeds out the spray hose with the turn of a lever. Keeping your hose on a reel is the best way to protect it from damage. Let's face it, 3/4" hose filled with material is heavy to handle. Our reel takes the hard work out of handling the hose. 200' of 3/4" hose with a 15 1/2" whip hose comes standard. An additional 100' of 3/4" hose can be added as an option. If you need even longer hose lengths, attachments can be added on at the gun end.



One the more invaluable options you can add is the Hot Maxx material heater. The Hot Maxx heater is typically used when spraying a heavy-bodied material and outside temperatures reach the 60° range. The Hot Maxx heater features a powerful diesel burner that transfers heat into the spray material circulating through a coil inside the heater. The result is thinner, easier to pump material and the ability to spray longer into cooler seasonal weather. Most material manufacturers offer guidelines for heating their products and should be consulted before using an auxiliary heat source.



For those contractors that utilize totes, we offer a 350-gallon tote package that eliminates the need for 55-gallon drums. You can order your rig with our tote bolted in place or utilize your own totes, which you can attach to the trailer. We encourage buying the tote already mounted on your rig. This allows you to refill the tote from barrels in your yard or you can utilize gravity filling from another tote into your own at the jobsite. Our standard system gives you the capability of refilling totes from a built-in siphon port or you can buy an optional high volume transfer pump to quickly refill the tote.



We also offer a hydraulic mixer to keep your materials properly mixed. The mixer mounts right on top of the tote.

We also offer a durable 8-R value insulated blanket to help maintain material temperatures. When using totes in conjunction with the Hot Maxx heater, you can recirculate the material from the tote, through the heater and back into the tote in little over an hour. When you're ready to spray, just flip the valve and send the material down the spray hose.

Simple controls run the hydraulics

- 1) Hose Reel
In/Out
- 2) Mixer
On/Off



In the event that your tote runs dry on the job, the remote suction pipe kit can draw material from 55-gallon drums placed on the ground next to the trailer. Use this low-volume, remote pump feature to either refill the tote or pump directly to the roof.

In the yard, you can refill your tote from 55-gallon drums before you head to the jobsite.
